Pre-game meals will be provided for regularly scheduled away games (not tournaments) when the team travels together via bus. Typical pre-game meals include a sandwich, chips, fruit, cookie or brownie, and water. Meals are purchased from vendors on a rotating basis and include local businesses such as Jason's Deli, Chick Fil-A, Shane's, Quiznos, etc. Brenda Ruth is the JCHS softball program meal coordinator for the 2011 season. She will make arrangements with the vendors for meal orders and will coordinate with volunteers to pick up the meals and deliver them to the school prior to bus departure for the away games noted above. Meals are priced at \$5 per player – some players may participate in both the JV and Varsity programs and therefore will participate in the pre-game meal program for both teams. Four (4) away games are combined Varsity/JV games and hence the two different price options for the JV pre-game meal program. Refunds are not provided in the event a player misses a game since meals are pre-ordered based on the number of players on the roster. Additional pre-game meals may be requested by the coaching staff for special events or tournament games and these will be handled on an ad-hoc basis.
